Mbalamusizza abantu ba Kabaka mwenna.

Nsubira abantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka abawangaalira e Bunaayira baagendayo nga baagala okusitula ku mbeera zaabwe mu ngeri emu oba endala era buli omu yajja e Bulaya mu ngeri ye. Twebaza Ssaabasajja Kabaka nti wadde guli bwegutyo abasinga obungi abakuhhaanye olwaleero, tusobola okusisinkana ng'abaana ab'enda emu wansi w'obukulembeze bw'Essaza lino erya Bungereza ne Ireland erikulemberwa Omubaka wa Ssaabasajja Kabaka Oweek. Ssaalongo Kibuuka Geoffrey ne bakulembeze banne bwe bakola emirimu gya Ssaabasajja Kabaka e Bunaayira eno.

Newankubadde buli omu akola ebintu eby'enjawulo era yajja mu ngeri ye, naye ensonga y'okwekulaakulanya ku Mawanga, mbakubiriza mugikwasize wamu nga muyambagana, mwenna mukulaakulanire wamu.

Bwe muba mukola enteekateeka z'okwekulaakulanya mujjukire n'eka gye musibuka nayo mutekeyo enkulaakulana eza ssekinnoomu ate n'ezawamu. Kino kijja kubayamba okunyweza emirandira eka ku butaka ate nga n'eno e Bunaayira muyimiridde bulungi.

Enteekateeka yammwe ey'Ekyeggulo eya buli mwaka mbasaba mugijumbire nnyo kuba etuukana bulungi n'ensonga Ssemasonga ey'okutaano **"Okunyweza obumu mu bantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka"**. Anti wano mukungaana ne mwogera ku nsonga ezibakwatako ne mufuna obubaka okuva Embuga, okuva ebirowoozo byammwe, n'okwanjulirwa enteekateeka z'Essaza ez'omwaka oguddako. Bino byonna byongerera okubakuumira awamu ng'abantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka.

Mbaakuutira okunyweza obuwangwa bwammwe buleme kubulira mu bulala obw'eno gye muwangaalira. Kyokka ate muteeke ekitiibwa mu buwangwa bw'abo be muwangala nabo mube n'enkwatagana ennungi musobole okubeerayo mu mirembe.

A bantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka ababeera e Bungereza mbalamusizza nnyo nnyini ddala. Mbeebaza emirimo gye mukola.

Njagala mu ngeri ey'enjawulo, okwebaza ennyo Oweek. Ssaalongo Kibuuka Geoffrey n'olukiiko lwe ssaako enkiiko za Ggombolola ezikola essaza olw'okuweereza Ssaabasajja Kabaka n'obuvumu era mu bwesimbu n'okunnyikiza okukunga abantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka mu ngeri ey'omuggundu. Tukimanyi nti ssikyangu okukulembera abantu ababeera e Bunaayira anti bangi ebibayitako kyokka olw'embeera y'abalabe ba Buganda ab'enjawulo n'enkzesa y'amutimbagano enkyamu ne beesanga nga babuuliddwa obulimba.

Abantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka, mbasaba okunyweza obumu. Obumu bujja kweyolekera nnyo mu ngeri gye tunaayambagana mu bwetaavu obw'enkulaakulana, obw'essanyu n'obwokusoomoozebwa. Obumu bwaffe bwe bijja okutusomosa amayengo, olwo tuwangule abalabe baffe betumanyi ne betutasuubira.

Mbajjukiza buli muntu okwenyigira mu kuwanirira ebikolebwa mu Bwakabaka ng'otoola ensimbi okugula satifikeeti mu nkola ya Luwalo Lwaffe. Ssinga buli muntu kino akikola nga bwaboneekereza "Tip" ababakolera emirimo egyenjawulo, tujja kutuuka kubwa naggwano.

Abantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka nnyongerera okubategeeza nti; Kabaka asimira abantu be enzizi mu bitundu by 'Obwakabaka ebitawaanyizibwa ennyo ekyeya! Twasaba buli Ssaza ly'Ebweru okusondayo oluzzi waakiri lumu lwa ddoola kakaaga (\$6000). Tusuubira Essaza Bungereza okukola ekisaana.

Nina essanyu okubaaniriza mwenna abavudde okumpi n'ewala okuba nga muzze ku kijjulo kino eky'e-byafaayo. Kansooke okwaniriza omumyuka wa Katikkiro wa Buganda Asooka, Owekitiibwa Prof Twaha Kaawaase n'okumwebaza okuba nga yakkiriza okutwegattako ku Kyeggulo kyaffe ekyo'mwaka guno. Nyaniriza abalangira n'abambejja, abakulembeze b'enzikiriza ez'enjawulo omuli; Abakristaayo, Abakulisitu, Abayisiraamu, Aba advent, Abapentekooti n'abatalina nzikiriza.

Nyongera okwaniriza abaami ba Ssaabasajja ku mitendera gyonna – Oweek. Ronald Lutaaya, Abamyuka, Abakungu, Abaami ku mabendobendo n'ab'emiruka, Ababaka b'Abataka, abakiise okuva mu Kabaka Foundation, n'abakulembeze b'Eksaakate kya Nnabagereka mu Bulaaya.

Nyaniriza ne sanyu lingi ddala abantu ba Ssaabasajja ne mikwano gya Buganda okuva munsu zonna n'amawanga ga Uganda amalala, abuvudde mu ssaza lino naabo abavudde ebweru wa Bungereza ne Ireland. Banaffe tubaniriza nnyo nnyini ddala! Mbebaza okutweggatako. Okubeerawo kwamwe kwongera okukasa n'okunyweeza obumu bwaffe. Ekyeggulo kino kya byafaayo olw'ensonga ssatu: Esooka, ky'ekyeggulo kya Buganda mu Ssaza lyaffe lino ekisoose okutegekebwa ebweru w'ekibuga London, kino kituwadde omukisa okusisinkana abantu ba Ssaabasajja abawangaalira mu kitundu kino naye nga bakalubirirwa okugenda ku mikolo mu London. Eky'okubiri, kye kijjulo ekisoose okumala enna-ku ssatu nambirira kasokanga Kyeggulo kitandika mu 2015. Enkola eno egaziyiziddwa etuwa omukisa si kujaguzwa kwokka wabula n'okwenyigira mu mbooji ez'amakulu, okwongera okumanyigana, n'okunyweza enkolagana ezitugatta.

Eky'okusatu, kino kye kijjulo ekisoose okubeera n'omu ku ba Ssabaminista nga omugenye omukulu. Twesiimye nnyo okuba nga ali naffe akawungeezi ka leero.

Bwe tutunuulira omwaka oguwedde, tulina bingi byetwenyumirizaamu ebibaddewo wadde mubaddemu n'okusoomozebwa mu birala. Munzikirize nokoleyo ebimu ku byo:

Tabamiruka eyasooka mu Bulaaya: Olukunnyaana lwa Buganda Bumu European Convention (BBECO), lwatuula mu kibuga Edmonton ekiri mu Bendobendo lya North London ne Lower Midlands. Omukolo guno ogw'byafaayo gwaliko Katikkiro wa Buganda, Oweek Charles Peter Mayiga; ab'ebitiibwa baminista abasoba mu musanvu n'abakungu abakulira ebitongole by'obwa Kabaka bangi. Olukungaana luno lwe lwasooka ku semazinga wa Bulaaya okugatta abantu ba Ssababasajja okuva mu masaza gonsatatule agali ku semazinga wa Bulaya; omuli erya Bungereza, Scandanavia ne Rhinlands. Twenyumiriza okuba nga ffe twalya empaga okutekateka omukolo guno ogujja okubeerangawo buli luvanyuma lwa myaka ebiri.

Buganda Bereavement Fund (BBF): Mu Gatonya (January) w'omwaka guno 2025, ekibiina kya Buganda Bereavement Fund (BBF) kyatandika emirimu gyaakyo, nga kati kirina bamemba abasoba mu 1,200. Wadde nga kya nakku nnyo nti bannaffe bana (4) baatugenzeeko mu kiseera kino, tusobodde okukungubaga n'abantu babwe mukiseera ekizibu kye babadde bayitamu. Twebaza bannakibiina ba BBF nga bayita mu kibiina kino basobodde okutoola £9000.00 eziweebwa buli family ya munnakibiina abeera atugenzeeko, okuyamba kunteekateeka z'okuwerekera bannakibiina bannaffe. Kino tukyenyumirizaamu nnyo okulaba nti abantu baffe naddala abo bannakibiina tebakyelalikirira singa omu ku bbo Mukama aba amuyise. Mu nkola eno, munnakibiina aba amanyi nti bwava mu bulamu bw'ensi eno, family ye tejjja kubeera yokka mu kukungubaga ne mu byensimbi. Kale awo nkubiriza bannaffe abatanegatta ku kibina kino bafube bakyegatteko.

Abakyala: Ekitongole kyaffe eky'abakyala kyakuza olunaku lw'abakyala mu nsi yonna (International Women's Day). Omukolo gwakunnyaanya abantu ba Ssaabasajja ne mikwano gyaabwe abaassukka mu 300. Omukolo guno gwaali mu Kkanisa ya St Jude ne St Aidan's e Thornton Heath mu South London. Omukolo guno gwagatta abakyala n'abawala okuva mu mbeera ez'enjawulo, baayogera ku bibakwaatako, baasanyuka era obumu bweyongera n'okwenyumiriza mu buwangwa bwabwe.

Okutuuzza abaami be Miruka: Ebbendobendo lya South ne West England (SWEB) lyatuuzza abaami b'emiruka abasookera ddala mu Ssaza lyaffe era gwe mukolo ogwasooka mu semazinga wa Bulaaya. Omukolo guno gwali Feltham mu Muluka gwa Kingston ne Richmond mu West London era gwaliko abantu abaassukka mu bikumi ebibiri mu atano.

Nasanyuka nnyo okulaba nti waliwo abantu bangi mu kitundu ekyo bulijjo abatatera kujja mu mikolo gya Buganda nga bajjumbidde omukolo guno era ne wano leero webali. Ab'emiruka tubaagaliza obuwereza obulungi. Nebaza omumyuka n'abaami beyakola nabo okuteekateeka omukolo ogwali omulungi ate omunyuvu ennyo.

Kabaka Birthday Run: Emisinde gy'amazaalibwa ga Kabaka gyateekebwatera mu Crystal Palace Park mu bbendobendo lya South ne West England. Emisinde gino gyaleta abantu bangi nnyo abasoba mu 500; omwali abantu ba Ssaabasajja ne mikwano gyaabwe okuva mu mawanga agenjawulo. Kino kyayongeraga okuggumiza obumu n'obwa seruganda mu Ssaza lyaffe. Abavubuka bangi bajjumbira era ekyo kyakwenyumirizamu nnyo. Emisinde gyatwaala olunaku lulamba. Tusiima nyo ekibiina kya basawo (Uganda Nurses and Midwives Association) abaaleeta ensiisira y'ebyobulamu okukebera n'okuwa amagezi ku ndwadde ezitali zimu. Neebaza omumyuka eyakulembera olutabaalo luno, abaami b'ebendobendo lya South ne West England, abakungu n'abaami okuva mu Ssaza lyonna abenyigira mu kuteekateeka emisinde gino.

Kabaka Foundation: Twafuuna omukisa omulangira Junju Kiweewa bweyakiriza nabeera naffe nga omugenyi omukulu mu kutongoza ekibiina kya Kabaka Foundation (UK) n'olukiiko olukulembeze ku mukolo ogwali mu President's Hotel mu kibuga London. Njoozayooza Ssenkulu n'abawereza abaasimibwa Beene okukulembera n'okuwereza ku lukiiko olwo era tubaagaliza buwanguzi.

Ekisaakate kya Nnabagereka: Abakulembeze b'ekisaakaate baatekateeka omusomo gw'abaana n'abavubuka ogwali e Morden mu South London nga gwaliko abavubuka abasoba mu 60. Baatendekebwa mu bintu ebikulu mu bulamu, omuli obuwangwa, eby'ensimbi, n'ebyenfuna n'omusingi gw'amaka amalungi. Bino nga bijja kubayamba okufuuka abantu ab'obuvunaanyizibwa mu nsi.

Food Bank: Ekitongole ky'embeera za bantu kyatandika okufuna n'okugabira abantu ba Ssaabasajja emmere n'ebikozesebwa nga kyatandikira mu masinziso; omuzigiti gw'e Pollards Hill, ekanisa ya St Jude Church n'eklezia ya St Chad Church mu South London. Wadde omulimu guno gulimu okusomozebwa mu ngeri ezitali zimu, nebaza abakungu abagutaddemu obudde era nsubira nti gyebujja gujja kutuuka mu mabbendobendo amalala gona.

Okusomezeebwa: Omwaka gwajiramu okusomozebwa. Twafirirwa abantu abaali abawereza mu community zaabwe, okuli Mukungu Caroline Namugabi ne Ambrose Kibuuka n'abalala. BBF yafirirwa bannakibiina abajjuvu bana. Emyoyo gyabwe giwummule mirembe.

Tukyalina okusomozebwa n'oluwalo. Essaza lyaffe terinaggumira ku nsonga eno, ate nga oluwalo lwelutambuza emirimu gya Bbeene. Nsaba buli omu akitwaale ng'obuvunanyizibwa bwe okuwaayo oluwalo buli mwaka

okulaba nga emirimu emirungi Ssaabasajja gyakola gigenda mu maaso nga omwo mwemuli okuyamba abantu abali mu bwetaavu. Newankubadde nga twolekagana n'ebizibu bino, obumalirivu bwaffe bujja kutuyamba okubivvunuka era tujjudde essuubi olw'ebijja mu maaso.

Mu mwaka ogujja, tuteekateeka okutegeka okukuza olunaku lw'abakyala mu nsi yonna ogusubirwa okwaniriza abantu okuva mu bifo bingi ebyenjwulo; okutegeka emisinde egy'amazaalibwa ga Kabaka nga ku luno tujja kuba mu East London. Tusubira okunnyikkiza ensonga ya Twezimbe (okukolera awamu okw'ekulakunya) n'okutandika ku nkola ya "Diaspora Gives Back" (abakugu abali kuno okukozesa obukugu bwaabe okuyamba abali eka) esubiirwa okutandika gye bujja. Nina esuubi nti bwetuba nga tukwatidde wamu tujja kusobola okwongeraga ku luwalo lwetuwereza embuga.

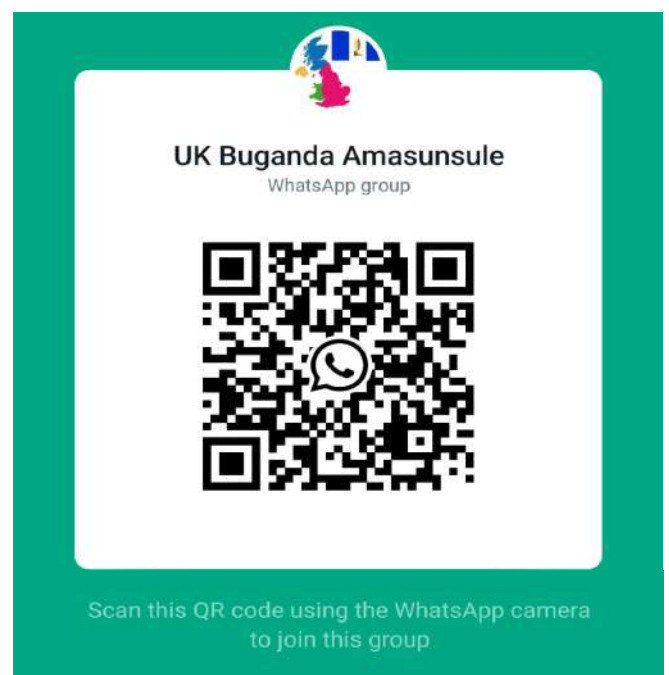

Tufube okusitula abavubuka baffe, nga tubaagaliza ensi ne nnono yaabwe tusobole okunyweza o'Buganda eyenkya mu Ssaza lyaffe.

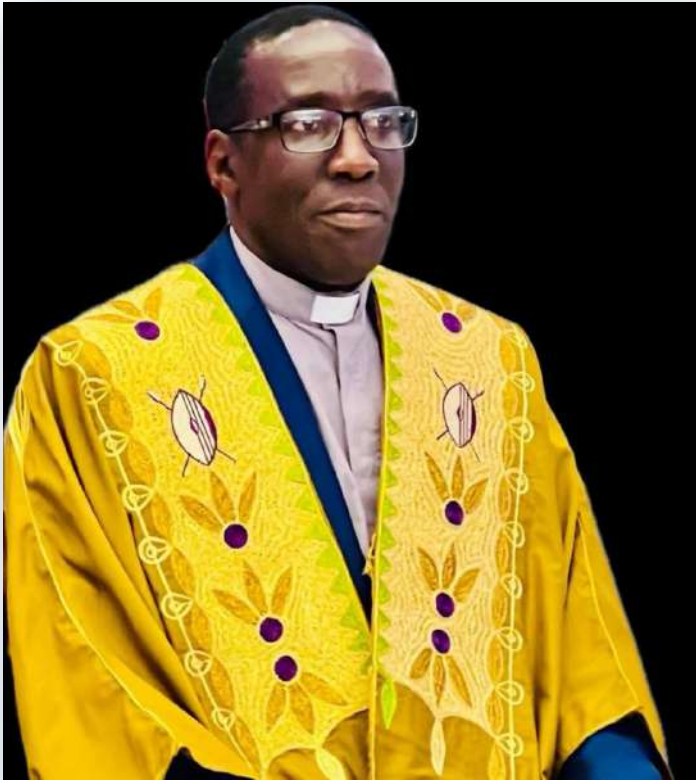

On behalf of the Bbendobendo of the North of England and the Midlands (Manchester), it gives me great honour and joy to warmly welcome you to this historic **Buganda Dinner (UK) 2025** here in Manchester. This celebration is a special milestone; it is **the very first for Buganda Dinner (UK) to be hosted outside London**. What a privilege that this moment belongs to us!

Before 2015, there was no Bbendobendo or formal Buganda structures outside London. But through the wisdom and visionary leadership of **Kabaka Ronald Muwenda Mutebi II**, (Ssaabasajja bwali Maasomoogi) His Majesty saw the need to extend the Kingdom's presence and representation to other regions of the United Kingdom. It was in February 2015 that His Majesty appointed me, **Rev. Enock Kiyaga Mayanja**, as the first Deputy Kabaka's Representative for the North of England and the Midlands. Following the Kabaka's instruction, we immediately began the work of establishing a functioning structure by setting up a working committee (Olukiiko lwe Bbendobendo olutuulako abaami ba Kabaka n'abawi b'amagezi). Later that same year, in November 2015, we became the **first Bbendobendo outside London to be officially inaugurated**. At the time, our base was in Manchester, with representation in Liverpool and Leeds.

Since those early beginnings, our Bbendobendo has grown steadily and now extends across multiple cities: **Sheffield, Derby, Coventry, Birmingham, Leicester, Loughborough**, and their

surrounding areas. We are proud to have effective representation in all these communities, proof of the strength and unity of Kabaka's subjects in this area (*Abantu ba Ssaabasajja abawangaalira mu kitundu kino*).

Over the past ten years, our Bbendobendo has achieved remarkable progress in promoting Buganda's culture and unity among Abantu ba Ssaabasajja living in this region. We have successfully organised a Cultural Festival to promote and preserve our heritage, encouraged the use of Luganda through regular community worship, and mobilised contributions towards Etofaali project in support of the Kingdom's development projects.

We have had the great honour of hosting Katikkiro Charles Peter Mayiga twice, and organising a royal dinner graced by the Nnabagereka as Chief Guest. Our community also held a successful Ekisaakaate for children and youth, participated actively in the Kabaka's Birthday Run, and have faithfully contributed towards Oluwalo Lwaffe and other kingdom initiatives.

Beyond these, we have worked to unite Ugandans across the North of England and Midlands, nurturing friendship and cooperation among people from different cities. Along the way, we have discovered and developed new talents and leaders, strengthening our network under the Essaza theme of Unity and Development.

In May 2023, His Majesty graciously renewed my appointment as Deputy Kabaka's Representative for this region. A new committee was subsequently elected and inaugurated by Omubaka Oweek Geoffrey Kibuuka in March 2024 at the Eastern Pearl Banqueting Hall in Manchester.

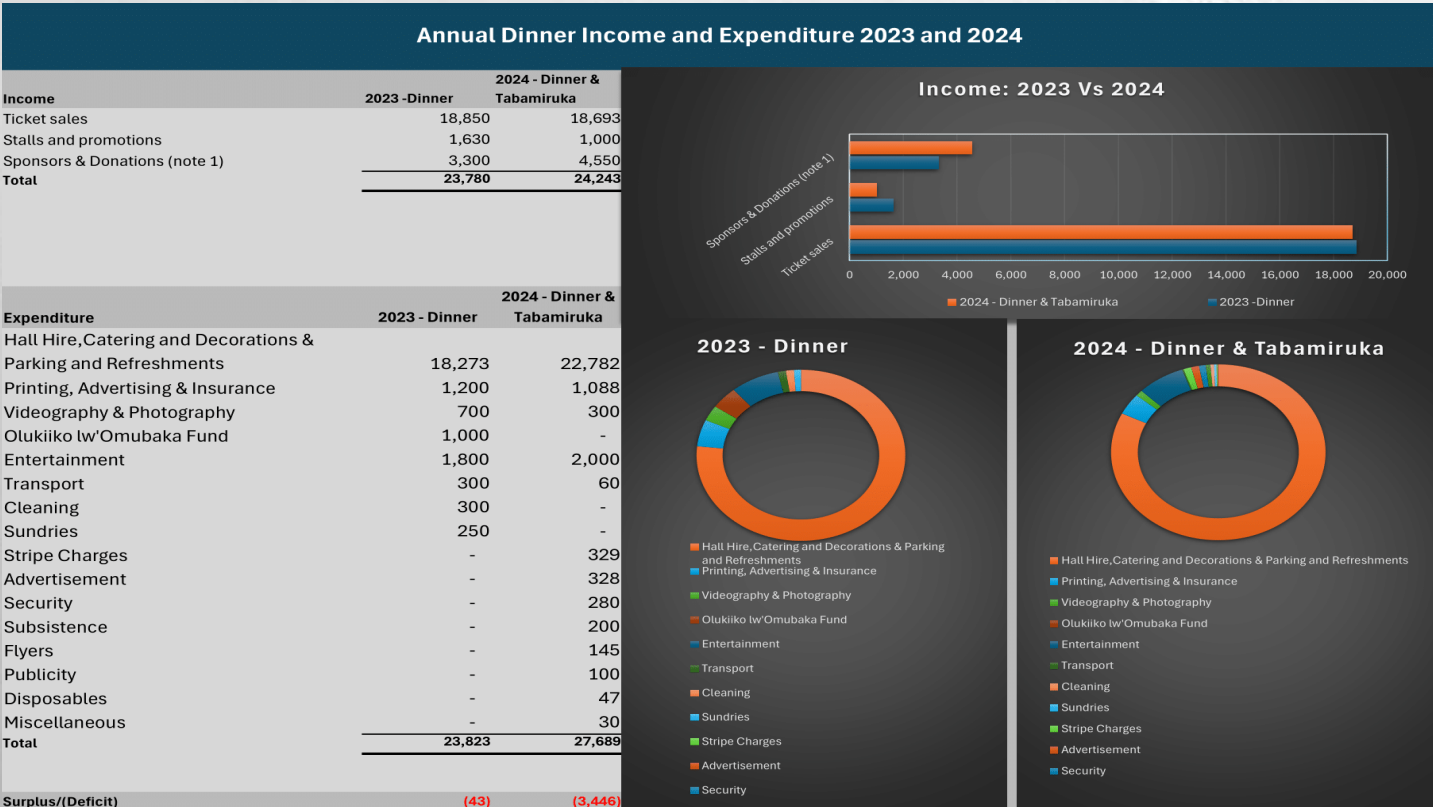

Buganda-UK Twezimbe: A Dignified Path to Wealth, Unity, and Legacy

Buganda-UK Twezimbe is a strategic investment initiative designed to empower the Buganda diaspora in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland through collective ownership of UK real estate. Led by Omuk. Robert Lwanga Mukiibi, the group embodies the spirit of “twezimbe”—let us build ourselves—by transforming pooled resources into tangible, income-generating assets that serve both personal prosperity and communal legacy.

At its core, Twezimbe operates as a Limited Partnership (LP) or Limited Liability Company (LLC), guided by a Buganda-UK Board and managed by professional property experts. Initially, members will be expected contribute a capital of about £5,000 (plus a modest administrative fee). Initially, the ambition is to raise £500,000 from 100 participants. Profits will be shared proportionally, and mem-

bers retain collective decision-making power on key strategic matters. The lock-in period typically spans 3–5 years, with opportunities for reinvestment and long-term growth.

The group’s focus is clear: acquiring residential and commercial properties in high-yield UK cities such as London, Liverpool and Manchester, where rental demand and capital appreciation offer strong returns. Compared to traditional savings options like High Street Bank ISAs, Twezimbe’s projected returns are significantly higher—8% annually versus 4%—translating to nearly double the income over a 3- or 5-year horizon. These projections are grounded in conservative forecasting and due diligence, with risk mitigation strategies that include diversification, professional oversight, and legal safeguards.

Beyond financial gain, Twezimbe will offer members an entry into property ownership, tax efficiency through depreciation and mortgage interest, and reduced individual exposure through shared investment. It is open to both active and passive investors, welcoming those who seek not only profit but purpose—those who wish to build something lasting for themselves, their families, and the wider Buganda community. The onboarding process will be simple: express interest, submit contact details, choose your investment tier (single or

double tranche), and begin the journey. The group is currently in its pre-formation stage, gathering interest and conducting market research, with legal setup and fundraising to follow in the coming months.

As a Buganda UK Youth Leader, I am proud to serve a community that is rich in culture, unity, and ambition. My role gives me the opportunity to engage with young people, listen to their struggles and guide them towards a brighter and more responsible future. The youth stage is one of the most important periods in life - it is where identity, purpose, and values are formed. If we lose our youth, we lose our future.

Unfortunately, many of our young people in the UK today are facing serious challenges. Statistics show that youth violence, poverty, and disconnection are affecting too many of our children:

- In 2024, over 240 teenagers were victims of knife crime in London alone.
- Across the UK, around 1 in 3 young people say they feel hopeless about their future (The Prince's Trust Youth Index, 2024).
- Youth unemployment among 16–24-year-olds remains high, with nearly 12% struggling to find work or training opportunities.
- Our Ugandan community in UK alone has lost over 8 young people to suicide since January 2024.

We are losing too many young people to gang life, knife crime, drugs, and poverty. Beyond that, we see a growing lack of respect - young people no longer listen to their parents, and when respect for parents is lost, respect for society soon follows. We need parents to regain control, reconnect with their children and guide them back into the community.

At Buganda UK, we are taking active steps to change this. We have held several events and workshops designed to encourage young people to open up, network, and think about their future. We teach them the values and expectations of being a Muganda man or woman - respect, integrity and community spirit. We remind them that being a Muganda is something to be proud of.

Our community is our village, and within this village lies the power to heal ourselves. We have professionals across the UK - lawyers, doctors, engineers,



teachers - who are willing to mentor our youth. If a child wants to become a lawyer, let's connect them with one by the age of 15. If they dream of becoming a doctor, let's get them talking to doctors early so they can focus and prepare. Through mentoring and guidance, we can help our young people dream bigger and achieve more.

One of our biggest concerns is the loss of language and culture. Many of our children cannot speak Luganda and that is heartbreaking. Language is the first step in identity. It connects us to who we are. Fortunately, we have a growing platform of youth who have taken it upon themselves to learn the language, and anyone interested can reach out for more information.

Looking ahead, Buganda UK Youth Department is determined to build on what we've started. We envision a future where every young Muganda in the UK has the tools, guidance, and pride to succeed both culturally and professionally.

Our plan includes:

- Establishing a Youth Mentorship Network that connects young people with professionals across different fields - law, medicine, business, technology, and the arts.
- Creating safe community hubs where

youth can meet regularly, discuss challenges, and take part in skills-building workshops such as financial literacy, public speaking and leadership.

- Expanding our cultural education programs to teach Luganda, Buganda history and traditional values in creative and interactive ways.
- Partnering with schools and local councils to support youth facing mental health challenges, school exclusion and/or involvement in crime.
- Launching youth volunteering and entrepreneurship projects so that our young people not only gain skills but also give back to their communities.

This is more than a plan - it's a movement. A movement to raise responsible, proud and visionary young Baganda who can lead their communities and inspire others across the UK.

Buganda UK is a self-healing community. Every challenge we face such as violence, poverty, disconnection etc can be addressed if we stand together. We have representatives all over the UK who are approachable, welcoming and ready to help but we cannot do it alone. We need parents to join us, to bring their children into the community and to work with us. Together, we can save the next generation, build strong cultural foundations, and create a future where every young Muganda residing in UK is proud, successful and deeply connected to their heritage.

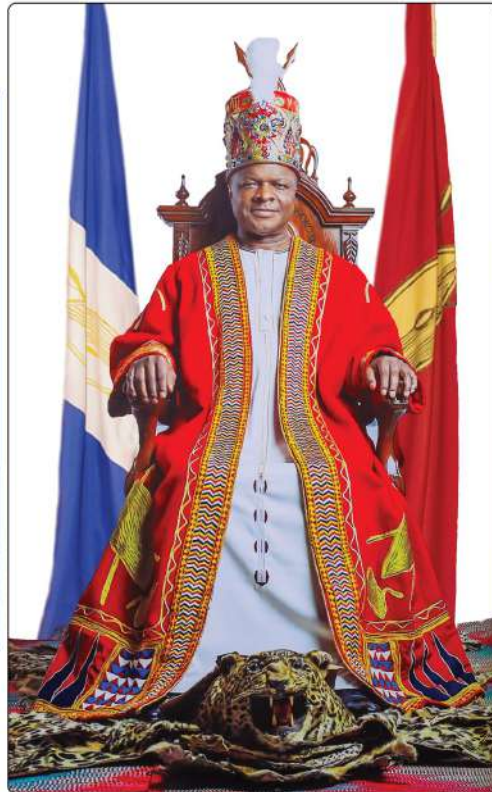

Kabaka Foundation UK & Ireland is a charitable organisation registered in the UK. Its main purpose is to improve the quality of life of people in Buganda / Uganda, and among the Ugandan diaspora in the UK & Ireland. It focuses on poverty relief, health, education, environment (flora & fauna), cultural heritage, and other charitable purposes.

Our **mission** is to improve the quality of life for individuals in Buganda/Uganda through tackling poverty, providing healthcare, advancing education, preserving environment and culture. Our **vision** is to be recognised as a leading charity for impactful work in those domains and the values.

Kabaka Foundation is involved in a number of programmes, which include medical camps (free clinics) branded “Tubeere Balamu” Health campaign. These clinics have been held in the following counties: Buddu, Busiro, Ssinga and Kyadondo. The clinics show that there is huge need for the services provided. As an example, in Masaka City (Ssaza Buddu), a health camp in December 2024 reached over 10,000 people, offering services such as eye care, cancer screening, and general medicine.

Kabaka Foundation also offers scholarships and support for schools, vocational / skills training for youth and vulnerable children.

We are also involved in programmes with Heifer International to introduce solar energy solutions, set up demonstration farms in every county (Ssaza) and to distribute cows to boost farming.

In May 2025 there was an official launch event in the UK for Kabaka Foundation UK & Ireland. A new executive committee for the UK & Ireland chapter was inaugurated. Their main role is to fundraise to support Ssabasajja Kabaka to meet the needs of his subjects in Uganda and beyond.

In pursuit of bridging the gap of health service delivery through screening, testing, vaccination, treatment and provision of linkage systems as well as health education to communities, Kabaka Foundation came up with Tubeere Balamu Health Campaign that is to be executed in Buganda Counties and beyond for a healthy population. A health initiative that has been extended to five Buganda Counties so far including, Buddu, Busiro, Ssinga, Kyadondo and Kyaggwe respectively.

During strengthening of Primary Health Care systems through Tubeere Balamu Health Campaign it was noted that people needed to continue accessing health services however, many were unable to cater for medical bills, and thus Kabaka Foundation in collaboration with the Ministry of Health of Buganda Kingdom and Weerinde Insurance Brokerage Services LTD partnered with Jubilee Health Insurance - Uganda and introduced Tubeere Balamu Insurance.

Tubeere Balamu Yinsuwa launched on 12th August 2025 by Prince Chwa during Tubeere Balamu Health Campaign execution in Kyaggwe County (Mukono District). It is a specialized micro medical insurance product developed with a goal of providing accessible and affordable health insurance for persons between one year and seventy years living in communities of Buganda Region and beyond.

At a PREMIUM of 198,000/= annually; one is to enjoy life and medical covers for treatment bills entailing: **1,000,000/=** for in-patient benefit; **1,000,000/=** for outpatient benefit; **2,000,000/=** for death cover; and **1,000,000/=** for permanent total disability be it accidental or from illness. **Critical illness for first time diagnosis** is payable to a maximum of **2,000,000/=**.

Tubeere Balamu Yinsuwa covers a wide range of diagnostics, including malaria, typhoid, diarrhea, bacterial infections and urinary tract infections. Additionally, it covers common parasitic infections like brucellosis, gastrointestinal diseases such as peptic ulcers and acute diarrhea, respiratory tract infections like cough, flu and pneumonia, genital urinary tract issues like STIs and UTIs, skin and integumental issues including fungal and bacterial infections, as well as minor injuries following trauma.

Efforts are on to sensitize communities about Tubeere Balamu Insurance through social media and all available platforms so as to secure population that can access health services at any time.

Era ntwala omukisa guno okwaniriza Abalangira n'Abambejja, Omumyuka wa Katikikiro Asooka - Oweekitiibwa Prof. Twaha Kawaase, Omubaka wa Ssaabasajja - Oweekitiibwa Godfrey Kibuuka, Omubaka Eyawummula - Oweekitiibwa Ronald L. Lutaaya, Abakungu n'Abaami ba Kabaka, Abakulu b'Amadiini, abantu ba Kabaka mwenna mu biti byammwe, bassebo ne bannyabo abazze wano olwaleero, mwenna mukoze kya tten-do.

Okuva olukiiko lw'Ababaka b'Abataka Abakulu b'Obusolya lwe lwatondebwawo mu 2017 n'ekigenderewa eky'okukunga abazzukulu nga tuyita mu Bika byabwe n'okuteekawo olutindo wakati waabwe n'Abataka Abakulu Ab'obusolya, waliwo ebintu bingi ebituukiddwako era bino byayanjulibwa mu Ttabamiruka w'Abataka Abakulu Aboobusolya nga 07.06. 2025 mu Hariss Academy e Pekham.

Wabula nga bwe tulya **Ekyeggulo kya Buganda** kino olwareero, tubasaba buli omu alowooze ku bino wammanga: Gyebuva ne gyebudda, buli muzadde yandyagadde ezzadde lye limufaanane mu ngeri emu oba endala. Era kino kisoboka, wewaawo nga okufaanana okumu kuba kulina kukolererwa muzadde. Nga ojjeeko endabika ey'obutonde n'amannya agaweebwa abaana mu Bika byabwe, omwana okufaanana abazadde mu bikolwa, mu ndowooza n'okutegeera okwabulijjo, okwo gattako omwana okwogera olulimi lwe oluzaalilana (Oluganda), bazadde be balina okumubeera okumpi okulaba nga omwana ono abayigirako ebyo bye bandyagedde abeere.

Kino bwekitakolebwa obuvunaanyizibwa abazadde ne tubukwasa abantu abalala, omwana oyo abeera ndabirwamu y'abo beyaweebwa era mwakulidde. N'olwekyo abazadde abatalera baana baabwe tebalina kwewuunya singa omwana alabika nga akola ebintu ebitabasanyusa. Kubanga kino kiba kitegeeza nti akola bya bali gy'abadde alekebwa era abeera ndabirwamu yaabo ababadde bamulinako obuvunaanyizibwa nga akula.

Abazadde okufaanana ebisolo n'ebinyonyi ebyo mu nsiko, tulina okutendeka abaana baffe kyetwagala babeere. Ekyokulabirako, y'empugu, bwezaala abaana mu kiyumba kyayo waggulu mu muti, esooka kubagabirira buli lwebaako eky'okulya ky'ereese. Naye akaseera katuuka empungu neeba nga bwereeta emmere esulawo busuuzi, abaana baayo nga balina okulaba engeri gye bagiteemaateemamu okugirya. Era bwe-wayitawo akabanga, empungu etandika okujjawo ebintu ebigonda kwe yabikira amagi.

Nga wayise akaseera, empungu etandika okuzimbulula ekiyumba kyonna, ekiraga abaana baayo bano nti y'essawa buli omu okubaako gy'alaga okutandika obulamu obuggya. Okukola bino byonna empungu ebeera esomesa baana baayo kugifaa-naana. N'olwekyo abaana baffe tubateeketeke okwanjanga ensi nga bakyali bato, so sikubategekera. Okuteekateeka omwana kimuleetera okweteegeera kiki kyali n'embeera emwe-toolodde.

Na bwegutyo, ffe Ababaka b'Abataka tuli wano okuyamba ku bajajaffe Abakulu b'Obusolya okubakubiriza okwettanira okumanya Ebika byammwe, n'okutambulira awamu kubanga muli ba musaayi gumu era Ebika z'ensibuko zammwe. Mu kino tubasaba okuwagira Ababaka abaabaweebwa bajajjamwe okubakwasizaako obuvunaanyizibwa obwabaweebwa, kubanga bayimiriddewo mu bigere bya Bataka Abakulu Aboobusolya. Lubeerera, mutuule mu nkiiko nabo nga babayise basobole okubanjulira ebifa ku Mbuga zammwe ez'Ebika, kino kyongere okubanyweza mu nnono zammwe, muleme kusigaza na mann-ya bunnya na kunenya abo bazzukulu bannamwe abagezaako okuweereza mu Bika byammwe.

Ababaka b'Abataka tuliwo okulaba nti mubeera ndabirwamu za Bika byammwe era olumu tubuuzibwa ebibuuzo ebikakali nga n'ebimu bikwasa ensanyi okubiddamu. Naye ng'Ababaka, tukufuba okulaba nti tutuukirira woofiisi y'Abataka Abakulu b'Obusolya okusobola okufuna ekituufu ku nsonga eziba ziri mu ddiro.

Okugeza waliwo ensonga y'Omukulebeze wa Uganda okugulira Abataka ettaka awagenda okuzimbibwa ekitebe kyabwe ekikulu - Lwattamu House, era n'okwetema obuwumbi bwa ssente ezigenda okuzimba ekizimbe kino. Abazzukulu ababeera emitala w'amayanja muteggeezebwa nti, mubeere bagumiikiriza ku nsonga eno kubanga emanyiddwa e Mbuga era mulindirire obubaka obutongole okuva mu Woofiisi y'Olukiiko lw'Abataka Abakulu b'Obusolya.
